Regular Cleaning

We recommend using our **Quartz Cleaner** and a microfibre cloth to rinse and wipe down your sink surface after use. Rubbing your sink dry will help minimise limescale build up. If limescale does build up, we recommend using a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water. Apply the solution to the entire surface of the sink.

Did you know? Use our **Quartz Mineral Oil** to protect and enhance your sinks' surface and act as natural barrier to limescale, watermarking and staining. Applying a thin layer every once in a while will enhance your sink and give it a nice shine.

Did you know? To clean your sink plug, leave it sitting in the vinegar water solution for a little while this will help loosen staining and debris off the waste and allow you to rub it off using an old toothbrush or microfibre cloth.

Removing Tougher stains

Heavier soiling and temporary staining can be removed with our biodegradable **Quartz Stain Remover**. This cleaner has been specifically formulated to remove stains and discolourations from your Quartz sink. Let the product sit for 5-10 minutes, but don't allow the solution to dry, then brush the area with a non abbrasive pad until clean, then rinse thoroughly. Ideally follow with a coat of **Quartz Mineral Oil** to rejuvinate and protect your sink.

Did you know? A natural remedy for staining and tougher soiling is a mixture bi-carb soda and lemon, leave soaking for a short time and remove with a micorfibre cloth. Be sure to rinse thouroughly and dry off afterwards.

Did you know? Tougher staining on your sink plug, like a build up of tea residue can be removed with our **Quartz Stain Remover**. Simply apply to the sink plug and allow to dwell for 5-10 minutes and use a non abbrasive pad to clean the staining, rinse thoroughly afterwards.

Metal Abrasions and Scratching

Utensils, pots, pans and other metal items can leave marks and 'scratching' on the surface of your sink. To remove these lines and markings, start by giving the sink a general clean. Then use a magic eraser (found in our **Quartz Cleaner Kit**) over the area, followed by a coat of **Quartz Mineral Oil.**

Did you know? Melamine (found in Magic Erasers) acts like extremely fine sandpaper and gets into those little grooves and is able to remove deposits (such as metal) from scratches.
